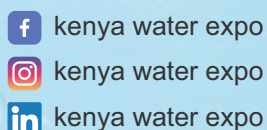

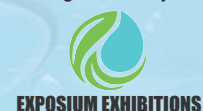

The government aims to achieve universal access to water and sanitation by 2030, as outlined in the National Water and Sanitation Investment Plan.

The Kenyan water industry is experiencing significant growth, particularly in the bottled water and water treatment sectors, driven by increasing demand for clean drinking water and addressing water scarcity challenges. Projections indicate substantial market expansion in the coming years, with notable investments in infrastructure development and technological advancements.
